Ketiv and Qere: The Phenomenon, Its Notation, and Its Reflection in Early Rabbinic Literature (Parts 3-4)

The first two parts of this article, which appeared in *Lešonénu* 70 (2008), pp. 55–73, discussed the methods used for signaling *ketiv* and *qere* throughout the generations and the exegetical difference between the written and read forms.
